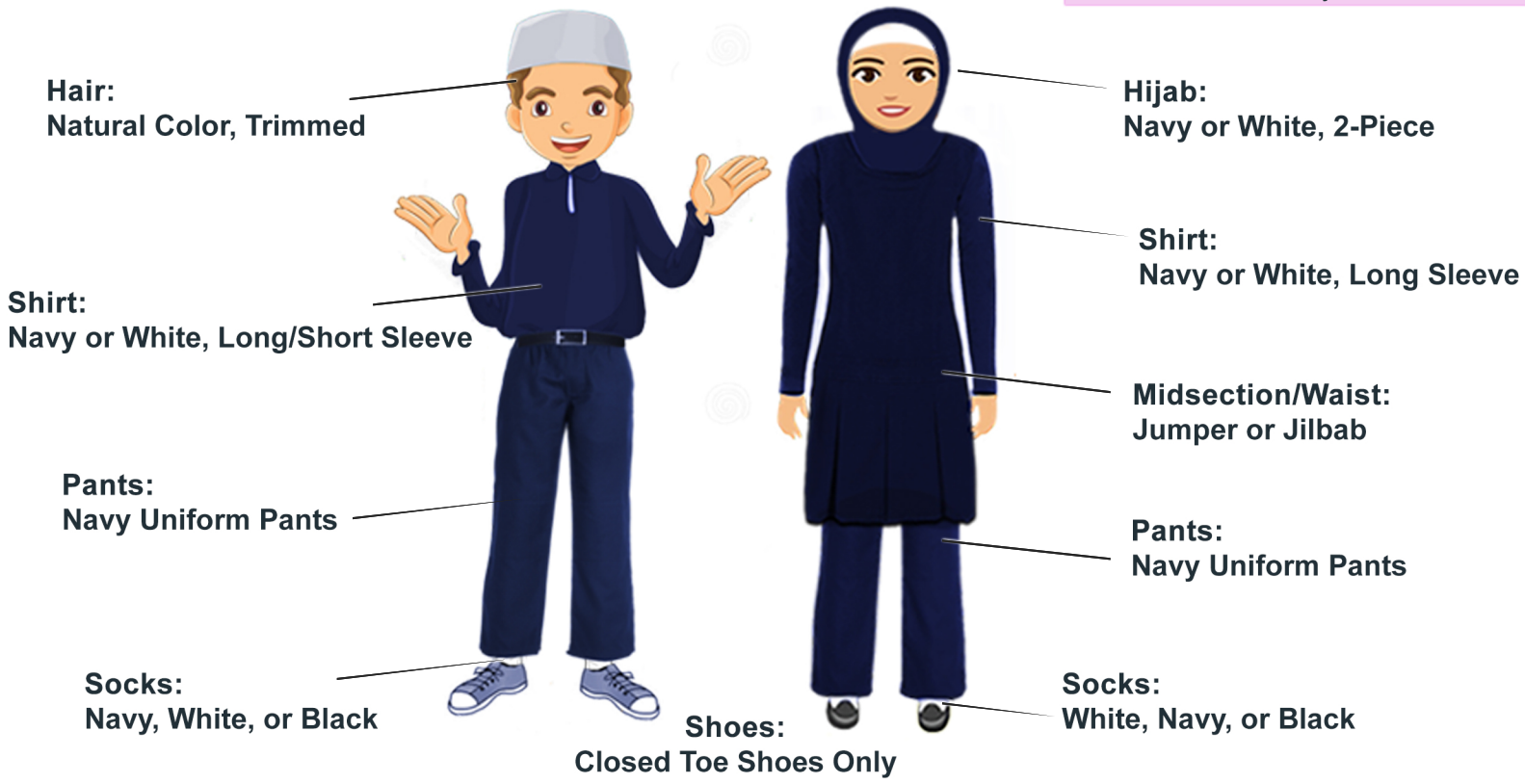
Girls Uniform Exceptions (K-3 Only)

Short Sleeves OK*

Jumper w/Leggings OK*

Plain Sweater OK*

* Still must be White or Navy



Hair

Students must have regular haircuts. No designs or layered haircuts will be allowed. Students must also have their natural hair color. No bleaching or "off" colors are allowed. Length of hair for boys should be a consideration.

Jewelry

No jewelry is permitted.

Make Up

Students may not wear make-up during school, including nail polish and lip gloss. Fingernails must also be trimmed and clean.

Clothing - Boys

KG-8th Grade:
 Long or short sleeve navy/white shirt
 Navy uniform pants
 White, navy, or black socks and closed-toe shoes
 For gym class and recess activities held in the gymnasium, sneakers must be worn.
 For gym class, boys in the 5th-8th grades are permitted to bring short and t-shirt for Gym.
 After gym class, boys must be in uniform once returning to their regular classes.

Clothing - Girls

Long sleeve white or navy collar shirt. Girls K-3 can wear short sleeves or a plain sweater. Still must be navy or white.
 Navy uniform pants with jumper covering where pants and shirt meet. Girls K-3 can wear a navy jumper with white leggings instead of pants.
 White or navy hijab Two pieces [i.e., not a isharrb])
 Girls in the 5th-8th grades must wear a jumper or jilbab over their shirts and pants to eliminate the showing of their mid-section.
 White, navy, or black socks and closed-toe shoe. For gym activities, including gym class and recess, sneakers must be worn.
 For girls in 5th-8th grade, a change of clothes may be brought in for gym class. Gym is not coed. A t-shirt and a pair of pants with sneakers. Girls may remove their hijab.
 After gym class, girl must be in uniform once returning to their regular classes.

Shoes

Shoes: Students must wear socks and closed-toe shoes. No sandals or slippers are allowed. During winter months, boots are suggested. However, all students are required to bring an extra pair of closed toe shoes. Upon entering school, All students are required to remove their boots and replace them with closed-toe shoes or sneakers.
